

SPS-related Technical Capacity Building Australia

Summary of Assistance given by
Australian Government agencies and
State and Territory Governments

1 July 2009 to 30 June 2011

- Over A\$37 million
- 43 individual Member, Observer and other countries,
 - mainly in the Asia-Pacific Region,
 - but also in Africa and
 - the Middle East

1 July 2009 to 30 June 2011

- Assistance took the form of:
 - information;
 - training;
 - "soft" infrastructure development; and
 - "hard" infrastructure development
- Covering food safety, animal health and plant protection

1 July 2009 to 30 June 2011

- 160 projects
 - 45 relating to plant protection,
 - 57 to animal health,
 - 14 to food safety,
 - 9 to a combination of animal health and plant protection,
 - 14 to a combination of plant protection and food safety and
 - 21 to a combination of animal health, plant protection and food safety.

1 July 2009 to 30 June 2011

- The details of projects are reported in G/SPS/GEN/717/Add.3 but it should be noted that
 - this is not an exhaustive compilation of all SPS related technical assistance provided; and
 - Many Australian Government agencies were involved.
