- **STDF/PG/350 “Global Phytosanitary Manuals, Standard Operating Procedures and Training Kits”**
- **Funded by the STDF contribution of 600 000, to be implemented by the IPPC Secretariat.**
- **The aim of the project is to increase the ability of developing countries to access basic national documentary procedures for effective implementation of the IPPC and its Standards.**

Permanent call for technical resources

- **Inventory of available technical resources in all languages, through a call by the IPPC Secretariat for resources directed to all IPPC contracting parties, RPPOs and relevant institutions and organizations.**
- **As of November 2011, nearly 300 manuals, reports, handbooks, guidelines, links, etc, have been received by the Secretariat.**
