Mr. Craig Fedchock is the Coordinator of the International Plant Protection Convention Secretariat, housed at the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization. He previously held a number of positions with the US Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, including Director of International Capacity Development, Associate Executive Director of Plant Health Programs, Director of the Phytosanitary Issues Management staff, Chief of Staff for APHIS International Services, and Director for Asia Trade Policy.

Mr. Fedchock was also the Director of Bilateral Sanitary and Phytosanitary Affairs at the Executive Office of the President, Office of the United States Trade Representative. Mr. Fedchock worked in the Codex Office of the USDA's Food Safety and Inspection Service, managed the National Advisory Committee on Microbiological Criteria for Foods; directed the U.S. Department of Commerce's International Trade Administration Operations Center and was a consultant to the U.S. Department of Defense. Mr. Fedchock served as a Russian linguist in the United States Army.
