




Export Vol > Production

### Safer Peppercorn

- **Problems** Peppercorn
  - Limitations of good practices (GAP, GHP & GMP)
  - Poor farm management
  - Over-use of pesticides & fertilizers
  - Lack of quality planting materials
  - Potential mycotoxins
  - Traceability




#### **GAPs**: Still being a big gap (V-C-L)
