- The aim of the project is to increase the ability of developing countries to access basic national documentary procedures for effective implementation of the IPPC and its Standards.






### Permanent call for technical resources

- Phytosanitary technical resources produced under the auspices of the IPPC Secretariat are identified with an IPPC symbol.




